Sub: Illegal/unauthorized deduction of employee salaries and deduction of deptt funds for NPGs

Sirs/Madams

The long practice of Nagaland government departments deducting the salaries of its employees for the so-called welfare of the Naga political groups is illegal, arbitrary, an open practice of corruption and in total violation of government service rules. No HoDs or departmental DDOs are authorized to deduct the salary of its employees for payment to any individuals or organisations. There is no standing government order to such effect and therefore, any departmental official carrying out such illegal activities is a serious offence and criminal charges are liable to be framed against such officials.

The state government is a different entity and the Naga political movement is a separate issue; therefore, the erring HoDs and DDOs shall be held fully responsible for such extra-constitutional acts and prosecuted.

Also, as per the 31<sup>st</sup> Oct 2013 Naga public resolution of “One Government One Tax”, no individual/organisation/department is supposed to pay any form of tax to any of the NPGs. At a time when the cry is reconciliation and peace, the government should not **encourage factionalism** in the movement by doling out money to all the factions but such action is deemed anti-Naga.
